



EMPIRE STATE PLAZA IMPROVEMENTS

CLA SITE is currently working with a team of consulting engineers for the New York State Office of General Services on the rehabilitation and reconstruction of the brick paver streets, walkways, vehicular entrances, and associated subsurface stormwater system at the Historic Empire State Plaza in Albany, New York. CLA SITE is providing site/civil services including existing conditions survey assistance, existing stormwater system modeling and evaluation, cost estimating, specifications, turning radius analysis, and construction documentation for the project layout, grading, and stormwater drainage infrastructure. The new improvements will enhance site access for facility and emergency vehicles, provide much needed brick paver and walkway restoration, and alleviate surface drainage and subsurface stormwater accumulation that is currently causing issues under the Plaza. CLA SITE and Design Team anticipates completing 100% Design Documents in Spring 2021.
